MEMORANDUM FOR GENERAL CANINE

SUBJECT: Evaluation of Portuguese Communication Security

1. Brigadier Tiltman called me this morning and informed me that he had received word from London that every effort was being made to expedite action on the paper covering the subject item which had been submitted to the British for comment. A British paper commenting on the U.S. paper has been submitted to British authorities concerned. Tiltman said that his information indicated, however, that there is little likelihood of any action on the paper prior to the next meeting of LSIB which is scheduled for the first week in November.

2. In this connection, a memorandum of conversation dated 27 September 1951, which I have just received covering a conversation between the [redacted]

"Jones brought up the PORTUGUESE question and said that we must bring the matter home to them. [redacted]"
