Reference: NSA Regulation 10-14 dated 31 December 54.

1. Referenced regulation established a Technical Journal and indicates that an Editorial Policy Board would be composed of representatives from PROD, C/SEC, R/D, AG, TEC, TNG, and P/P.

2. It is my understanding that the Journal is to be professional and technical in nature and will probably be disseminated to consumers, GCHQ, and cooperating agencies.

3. Because of its very technical nature, the Journal will contain from time to time various levels of classified material. No doubt in formulating editorial policies, security problems will arise which should be passed on by this Division. While I am sure that such problems will be referred promptly to this Division by the Board and editorial staff, it is possible that the security aspects of certain matters will not be recognized and, therefore, will not be referred to this Division.

4. To prevent this and to assist in ensuring that all security problems are promptly resolved, I recommend that SEC be included in membership on the Board as a security advisor.
