Subject: Allied (NATO) Communication Security.

Reference: CIB # 00060 dated 1 June 1953.

1. In addition to the guidance for the U.S. Delegation provided in the referenced serial, the following extract from the final transcript of the minutes of the 86th (Special) USCIB Meeting is forwarded for information:

"Mr. Sheldon referred to the last paragraph on page 2 of the U.K. position paper and suggested that the U.S. delegation might need some guidance with respect to including the French with the U.K. and U.S. in a tripartite committee to deal with other members of NATO on the improvement of cipher security.

"After some discussion, the Chairman said that guidance for the committee would be to tell the British that USCIB will be glad to discuss that proposal when the French cipher system is satisfactory."
