MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR, NATIONAL SECURITY AGENCY

Subject: U.K./U.S. Communications Security  
Conference, 1953.

Reference: JCS 2074/28.

1. With reference to your memorandum for the Joint Chiefs of Staff on the above subject dated 17 August 1953 (JCS 2074/28), the Joint Chiefs of Staff:

a. Concurred in the designation of Mr. W. F. Friedman as Head of the U.S. Delegation to the Conference.

b. Agreed that representatives from each Service would be designated for participation in the preliminary discussions in London and in Phases I and II of the Conference, as well as in preliminary U.S. discussions prior to departure for London.

2. The Chief of Staff, U.S. Army, the Chief of Naval Operations, and the Chief of Staff, U.S. Air Force have been requested to furnish the names of their representatives direct to you.
