

Treatment of names in VENONA translations

The determination on the release/denial of names of individuals contained in the translations was made after balancing the public's right to disclosure against the individual's right to privacy. If a name was previously released by the FBI in the context of Soviet espionage and/or the person was prosecuted for such activity, the name is being released regardless of context (i.e., whether it appears as a truename in the text of the message or in a footnote as a result of a U.S. government equation).

For the remainder of the names, determination regarding the release/protection of the names is based on the following analysis. Truenames are protected if they are contained in the body of a message in an ambiguous or questionable context. In such cases, the personal privacy concern outweighs the public's right to information which could lead to unfair speculation about the individual. In other instances truenames are released because personal privacy is not at issue. For example, if a message says that Jones may be approachable, Jones is protected because there is no factual information about Jones's involvement in espionage. Likewise if Jones's name appears surrounded by unrecovered text so that no context can be established for the name, the name is protected. On the other hand, if Jones is identified simply as an atomic bomb scientist or the message says that Jones provided documents to a KGB agent, Jones is released. To contrast, if Jones is identified by a codename in the body of a message and is only identified by truename in a U.S. government-written footnote, Jones is protected in the footnote.

During the review of material for the second release, it was decided these rules needed to be fine tuned due to the difference in the names included in the messages. It was determined that foreign diplomats and officials have a diminished right to privacy due to the public exposure demanded by their positions. A private citizen of a foreign country, however, is entitled to the same privacy rights as a citizen of the U.S. Privacy rights are negated, however in the following circumstances:

--Because we do not consider the protection of Soviet citizens in these KGB messages, we also release the names of citizens of Soviet-aligned countries (e.g., Yugoslavia, Czechoslovakia) even if identified in a footnote or appearing in an ambiguous context.

--In addition, notorious people, those associated with the assassination of Trotsky/attempt to free his assassin from a Mexican prison and "illegals" are not deemed to require personal privacy protection.

By applying this analysis the name of an individual may be protected in some contexts and not others, but this ensures consistency regarding the criteria used and ensures that release is not made of information which would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

(They have not been incorporated into the main list because of a change of software that precluded our ability to incorporate them in alphabetical order.)

RATIONALE FOR PROTECTION OF NAMES: The names deleted are protected pursuant to (b)(6). Determination regarding denial of names was made based on NSA and FBI research and a weighing of the privacy interests against the public interests in release.

Because the translations were originally provided to the FBI for counterintelligence/law enforcement purposes, we consulted with the FBI regarding the release of the names in the documents to ensure that release of any of the names would not affect ongoing investigations or otherwise impact FBI activities. The FBI FOIA office reviewed the material and, pursuant to the first release, initially suggested that 34 names be protected. At our request FBI further researched the 34 names and provided justification for releasing all but 20 names. FBI suggested that the 20 names be protected based on the following criteria: 1) FBI has no information indicating that these individuals are deceased; 2) The names have not been publicly disclosed by an FBI FOIA/PA release; and 3) The individuals are not of such notoriety as to diminish expectations of privacy. [redacted] (FBI FOIA office) stated that the names are not FBI information, and FBI would not object to the release of any of the names if NSA determines they are releasable. The FBI FOIA office does not consider our consultation as an FOIA consultation since they were required to go beyond FOIA processing in researching the names. Although FBI initially asked that we protect the names pursuant to 5 USC 552 (b)(7)(C), in the final analysis, [redacted] agrees that FBI simply based its release/denial determination on (b)(7)(C) criteria. Therefore, in responding to the FOIA requesters, we cite only (b)(6) for NSA's deletions and not (b)(7)(C) on behalf of the FBI.

In reaching our decision on whether to protect names under (b)(6), we took the FBI recommendations into account because a previous governmental release of a name in an espionage context or the notoriety of a person would override an individual's privacy interests.

The notation (b7c) beside a name indicates FBI's suggestion that the name be protected.


