Comments: [i] AKASTO: Col. N.I. NIKITURAEV. Soviet Military and  
Air Attaché in STOCKHOLM.

[ii] MUSICAL APPARATUS: Not clear whether this is synonymous with  
MUSIC (a W/T set) or whether it has a  
wider meaning.

[iii] ADMINISTR[A]TOR: Unidentified MOSCOW addressee and  
signatory. Although the last syllable is  
unrecoverable, technical evidence shows that  
the word is ADMINISTRATOR and not  
ADMINISTRATION.
