Notes: [i] Possibly used loosely for "battle-cruisers". The battle-cruiser GNEISENAU was damaged by bombing at KIEL on February 27th, 1942.

Comments: [i] Name No. 42 : In 1943 this is thought to refer to Capt. (1st Rank) M. A. VOZNETSOV, but may not do so at this date.

[ii] YanEX : Unidentified cover-name. See also STOCKHOLM's No. 1428 of 21st January 1942 (3/NBF/T1428), where the name is in quotes.

[iii] Name No. 64 : Unidentified STOCKHOLM Signatory.
